# Coffee Koozie

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### **Fabric Requirements:**

One Mini Charm Pack or twelve 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle of backing fabric 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle of batting

## **Additional Supplies:**

One 3/4" button
One elastic hair band
Coordinating thread

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## Coffee Koozie

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout, unless otherwise noted.

#### **Coffee Koozie Front:**

Select six light and six dark squares to use.

Assemble one light 2 ½" square and one dark 2 ½" square.

Two-Patch Unit should measure 2 ½" x 4 ½".

Make six.



With right sides facing and alternating light and dark squares, layer two Two-Patch Units on the left end of the batting. Match the center seams.

Sew along the right edge of the Two-Patch Units.

Press in place.



Repeat with the remaining Two-Patch Units, alternating light and dark squares.

Press the Unfinished Coffee Koozie Front flat.



Pin the template on top of the Unfinished Coffee Koozie Front. Match up seam lines on the left side, right side and center of the template.

Cut along the outside edge of the template.



### **Coffee Koozie Assembly:**

With right sides facing, layer the Coffee Koozie Front and the  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " backing.

Center an elastic band on one side between the two layers using the placement guide on the template and pin in place.

Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " around the edge of the koozie leaving a 2" opening in one section. Backstitch at the beginning and end.



Trim the  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " backing to match the edge of the Coffee Koozie. Clip each corner off the Coffee Koozie just outside the stitch line to remove bulk.



Turn right side out and press the opening closed.

Stitch around the Coffee Koozie ¼" from the edge. Use matching thread. Backstitch at the beginning and end.



Using your coffee mug as a guide, mark a spot for the button on the opposite end of the Coffee Koozie from the elastic band.

Sew button in place.
